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ABOUT SARAWAK



Sarawak was part of the Sultanate of Brunei some 200 years ago and was ceded to Sir James Brook as a reward for helping the sultanate in putting down the rebellion. From 1941-1945, it was under Japanese occupation. It became a British Crown Colony in 1st July 1946 until 1963 when Sarawak gained independence and became part of Malaysia.

Sarawak is the biggest and the most diverse state in Malaysia with 27 ethnic groups making up its population of 2.17 million people. Much of the state is still forested. The state enjoys sunshine from March to October with rains from November to February each year due to the monsoon season. The official language is Bahasa Malaysia, however, English and Mandarin are widely spoken.

ABOUT KUCHING

Kuching, derived from the Malay word kucing, meaning cat is the capital and largest city in Sarawak. With a population of about 800,000, the city prides itself as being one of the most multi-racial cities in Malaysia. Despite modernization, Kuching has retained its old charm with many of the buildings of the colonial era remains intact.

KUCHING CITY TOUR (3 HOURS)

Kuching City Tour. Places of interest includes **Kuching South City Council Building, Cat Monement, China Town, Kuching Waterfront, Old Kuching town, Old Court House, Square Tower & the renowned Sarawak Musuem. (Pick-up: 9.00am)**

SARAWAK CULTURAL VILLAGE (4 HOURS) RM127.20 PER PERSON

Sprawling over an area of 17 acres of land at the foot of Mt. Santubong, Sarawak Cultural Village, a unique award winning "Living Museum", offers an excellent introduction to local rich cultural diversity and lifestyles. Explore all the unique replicas of the buildings/dwelling of the major ethnic groups in Sarawa:- Iban Bidayuah and Orang Ulu longhouse a Penan jungle settlement, a Melanau tall-house, a Malay town house and a chinese farm house. All buildings are staffed with members of the various ethnic groups in their traditional costume. Watch the spectacular multi-cultural show at the mini-theatre. **(Pick-up: 8.30am)**

SEMENGGOH WILDLIFE REHABILITATION CENTER (3 HOURS)

Established in 1975, 24KM from Kuching, this centre is home to semi-wild orang-utan found either injured/orphaned in the forest, or rescued from captivity and trained to survive in the surrounding forest reserve. Watch the orang-utan that usually return to the centre at feeding time. (Sightings cannot be guaranteed as orang-utan are semi-will and free to roam). **(Pick-up: 8.00am)**

JONG'S CROCODILE FARM (4 HOURS) RM95.40 PER PERSON

Jong's Crocodile Farm and mini-zoo is Located 22 KM from Kuching, approximately 40 minutes drive by car. This is not only Malaysia's oldest crocodile farm but also one of the biggest which has a collection over 1,000 of these fearsome predators bred in captivity in about 25 acres of land. The farm also has a mini-zoo which has collection of animals ranging from bear cats, macaques, porcupines. The farm,surrounded by natural setting allows animals to live & move freely. **(Pick-up: 9.00am)**

ANNAH RAIS LONGHOUSE (4 HOURS)

One of the most commonly visited longhouses, Annah Rais Longhouse is a 200 years old settlement of the Bidayuh tribe located 60KM from Kuching city. It is well known for its beautiful natural surroundings and uniqueness of the life style of its village. The longhouse is built based on Bidayuh's traditional architectural design using bamboo as the main building material. Human skulls can still be seen hanging over the fire place inside the Headhouse, the "Baruk". **(Pick-up: 9.00am)**

BAU FAIRY & WIND CAVE (4-5 HOURS) M106/- PER PERSON

Fairy Cave is small limestone cave with formation resemble human and animal figures. Access to the cave is by means of walkways and concrete stairways. Venturing around, you get to see many stalagmies and stalactite some of which are over 15 feet tall. There is even a stalactite that resembles the Chinese Goddess of Mercy. **The Wind Cave**, adjacent alongside the river, has unlit boardwalks run through the cave allow visitors to wander along the three main passages with chattering bats swooping overhead. **(Pick-up: 9.00am)**

BAKO NATIONAL PARK (5-6 HOURS)

Gazetted in 1957, **Bako National Park** is Sarawak's oldest national park and is a 27 sq-km natural sanctuary located on a jagged peninsula nestled between the mouths of the Sarawak and Bako Rivers and jutting out into the South China Sea. Bako is well known for its incredible biodiversity from pitcher plants to bearded pigs, proboscis monkeys. There are various species of mammals, 24 reptiles species and 184 bird species, some of which are migrant species. There are also a number of walking and jungle trekking trails in the park. Packed lunch is included. **(Pick-up 8.30am)**

GUNUNG GADING NATION PARK (6 HOURS)

The Park consists of rugged mountain peaks which provide a scenic backdrop to the nearby beaches at Pandar Siar. The peak of the park is 900 meters high. Most visitors come to see the rare Rafflesia Tuanmudae (World's largest flower) which appears year round but at unpredictable times and varying location. The flowers only last for a few days. **(Pick-up: 9.00am)**

KUBAH NATIONAL PARK (6 HOURS)

Kuban National Park is located 20KM from Kuching and is dominated by three mountains: Mount Serapi, Mout Selang and Mount Sendok. Kubank National Park is home to a largevariety of wildlife including bearded pigs, black hornbills, mousedeer, squirrels, snakes and lizards. **(Pick-up: 9.00am)**

MATANG WILDLIFE CENTRE (4 HOURS)

Matang Wildlife Centre is the biggest attraction at Kubah National Park. The main attraction at the centre is the orangutans. Other attractions include crocodiles, Sambar Deer, Sun Bears, Bear Cats and Civets. In 2005, a previously unknown camivore, nicknamed the cat-fox was discovered in Borneo, believed to be a civet. **(Pick-up: 9.00am)**

SANTUBONG WILDLIFE CRUISE(3.5 HOURS)

The tour takes yhou around the rivers cape of Santubong peninsular. The boat roams the mangrove-lined rivers looking for wildlife and enrout , you will pass by Salak Malay Kampung. As the light starts to fade, we go in search of the rare proboscis monkdys, crocodiles and other wildlifes (Sighting is not guarantee). **(Pick-up: 3.30pm)**

MANGROVE & IRRAWADDY DOLPHIN CRUISE (3 HOURS)

Cruise from Sarawak Boat Club to the mouth of the Santubong River. The boat ride takes you around the peninsula of Santubong in search of the Irrawaddy dolphins. Dolphins watch my place before or after the mangrove cruise depending on tidal conditions. (Sighting is not guarantee). **(Pick-up: 8.30am)**

SATANG ISLANDS + SNORKELING (6 HOURS)

Satang comprises of two islands, Besar(big) and Kecil (small) and are located just outside the coastal area. Snorkelling and diving are activities are done around Satang Besar with variety of corals and marine life. **(Pick-up: 8.30am)**

SEMADANG DISCOVERY KAYAKING (5 HOURS)

Explore Semadang river by a kayak and discover the beautiful scenery and the tranquility of Sarawak's rainforest. Take a village walk at the Bidayuh Village and stopover at Sibudak for swimming. **(Pick-up: 9.30am)**
